Position Overview

Eligibility Requirements

2. Maintain a minimum 2.7 cumulative GPA
3. Profess Jesus Christ as Lord
4. Committed to living a consistent life of Christian witness on and off campus, representing Christ and Olivet

- Strong communication and people skills.
- Organized and able to juggle multiple tasks.
- Passionate about helping commuter students feel connected.
- Comfortable working independently and with a team.
